Discussion: WSDOT 2025-2027 Consolidated Grant Results

Jean Kim, PSRC, briefed the committee on the results of the WSDOT Consolidated Grant for the 2025-2027 biennium. In our region, encompassing King, Pierce, and Snohomish counties, a total of 27 projects were funded, including 10 projects awarded in 2022 for four years. CMAC will hold a Regional Priority Ranking debrief in November, and the next funding process is scheduled for the summer of 2026.

committee reviewed and refined existing strategies to better reflect current needs.

Committee members provided feedback to clarify desired outcomes and revise strategies and action step statements. In August, staff will share the draft strategies with CMAC for additional review and revisions.
