- Future system assessment in-progress


Builds on past PSRC transit access work

Accounts for the needs of effective transit service



Methodology

- Land use density & Supporting transit service
- Transit accessibility: what opportunities can people access via transit?
- Equity: examines who can access transit?
- Access to transit: <u>how</u> can people reach transit.



Metrics under "how" people access transit

Percent of streets on regional Pedestrian/Bicycle High Injury
Network

Pedestrian network completeness

Average bicycle level of traffic stress

Route directness index to transit

Manage parking supply & demand



Next Steps

- Consultant team finalizing draft regional assessment.
- PSRC staff review, comment, incorporation into draft RTP.
- Opportunity for feedback on the regional assessment through draft RTP comment period.
- Next phase: include developing interactive "storymap" type tool for local jurisdictions and transit agencies.
