Methodology



- Survey of residents in King, Snohomish, Pierce, and Kitsap counties
- Survey conducted March 3 12, 2025 in English and Spanish
- Mixed-mode telephone and web (email-/text-to-web) methodology
 - Phone interviews conducted by trained, professional interviewers; landlines and mobile phones included
 - Email and text message invitations to complete the survey online
- 2,000 interviews; overall effective margin of error ±2.8 percentage points
 - King County: n=750; effective MoE= ± 3.9
 - North King/Seattle: n=255; MoE= ±6.1
 - East King: n=241; MoE= ± 6.3
 - South King: n=254; $MoE=\pm6.2$
 - Pierce County: n=500; MoE= ±4.4
 - Snohomish County: n=450; MoE= ±4.6
 - Kitsap County: n=300; MoE= ±5.7

Please note that due to rounding, some percentages may not add up to exactly 100%.

Key Takeaways



- Traffic congestion, public transit, and road maintenance are dominant concerns in the region when it comes to transportation.
- While not as top-of-mind, residents are concerned about road safety. Improving safety for road users is a priority to residents across the region especially for drivers, but also for pedestrians and bicyclists.
- Residents tend to see other drivers' behaviors as a bigger contributor to safety problems than lack of safety infrastructure.
- That said, most support changes to the built environment when connected to how those changes can alter driver behaviors and build safer driving into the system.

Most Important Transportation Problem



Traffic and public transportation issues top the list of transportation problems in Puget Sound, with over a quarter of residents mentioning each.

Thinking about all of the ways people get around Puget Sound, what do you think is the most important <u>transportation</u> problem facing the Puget Sound region today?



Most Important Transportation Problem



Traffic is a top-of-mind concern across counties, while public transportation is more of a concern in King County. Ferry-related issues are mentioned by about one-in-five Kitsap residents.




Biggest Local Road Safety Concern

When you think about how you get around where you live, what is your biggest concern when it comes to safety on our roads?









Transportation Priorities




Reliable, well-maintained roads and highways and reduced traffic across the region are the top two priorities for residents across Puget Sound.



Top Transportation Priorities by County




The top two highest rated priorities are consistent across counties. Transit service-related issues beat out driver safety in King County.




Road Safety Perceptions

Perceived Safety




Across modes, residents tend to feel safest moving around residential streets. Majorities feel unsafe walking or bicycling along or crossing major roadways.



Perceived Walking Safety by County



Only about a quarter of Pierce, Snohomish, and Kitsap residents say they feel very safe walking along residential streets in their neighborhoods, and about one-in-ten feel very safe walking along major roadways.




Perceived Safety Walking by Subgroups



Rural residents feel less safe walking on both major roadways and residential streets than those in urban and suburban areas.

- Walking along or crossing major roadways in your area




Perceived Safety Bicycling by Subgroups

- Bicycling along or crossing major roadways in your area




Women tend to feel less safe than men driving on major roadways.



Perceived Biking Safety by County




Outside of King County, less than half of residents say they feel safe bicycling along residential streets.



Perceived Driving Safety by County




Residents of Pierce County tend to be most concerned about driving safety on all road types compared to other counties.



Road Safety Problems




About 70% of residents say distracted driving and drivers looking at their phones are problems, and about a third say speeding and lack of enforcement for unsafe driving are very big problems.


Residents are open to changing the built environment. A third strongly agree we need to spend money on changing transportation infrastructure and 7-in-10 overall agree. They also see a need for more education and enforcement.

We need to spend money on changing our transportation infrastructure so that additional safety measures are built into the transportation system automatically, instead of relying on drivers, bicyclists, and pedestrians to behave.

We need more persuasive public messaging and required driver education courses to encourage and change behaviors on the road.

We need to spend more time and money on law enforcement officers patrolling and enforcing the rules of the road, like ticketing drivers who speed, drive distracted, or break the law.


We need more tools to enforce good behavior on the roads, like red-light cameras and speed cameras that issue tickets so that drivers face financial penalties and change their behavior.

Law enforcement funding is most popular in Pierce and Kitsap counties, where about 7-in-10 say they agree there is a need.




Infrastructure Statement by Subgroups



Younger residents, Hispanic/Latinos, and those who do not drive are more likely to support changing infrastructure.




Messaging & Education Statement by Subgroups

We need more persuasive public messaging and required driver education courses to encourage and change behaviors on the road.




Officers Statement by Subgroups

We need to spend more time and money on law enforcement officers patrolling and enforcing the rules of the road, like ticketing drivers who speed, drive distracted, or break the law.




Enforcement Tools Statement by Subgroups



Older residents tend to be more open to tools like automated enforcement.






About half of residents agree with prioritizing road safety over travel times and expanding road capacity.



Traffic deaths have been increasing. We need to spend the money to stop this trend even if it means people need to pay a few dollars more per year in taxes.



About half of residents across counties prioritize safety across tradeoffs.




Slower Speeds Statement by Subgroups

Even if it means it will take me a few minutes longer to get where I'm going, I support slower speeds on our roads to improve safety for all users.




Traffic Deaths Statement by Subgroups



Non-drivers, Hispanic/Latino residents, and younger residents tend to be more supportive of spending more money to prevent traffic deaths.

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


Road Capacity Statement by Subgroups

I would support spending more money on improving safety in our transportation system even if it means less money is spent on expanding road capacity.













Perceived Walking Safety by Region













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
