## Who we are

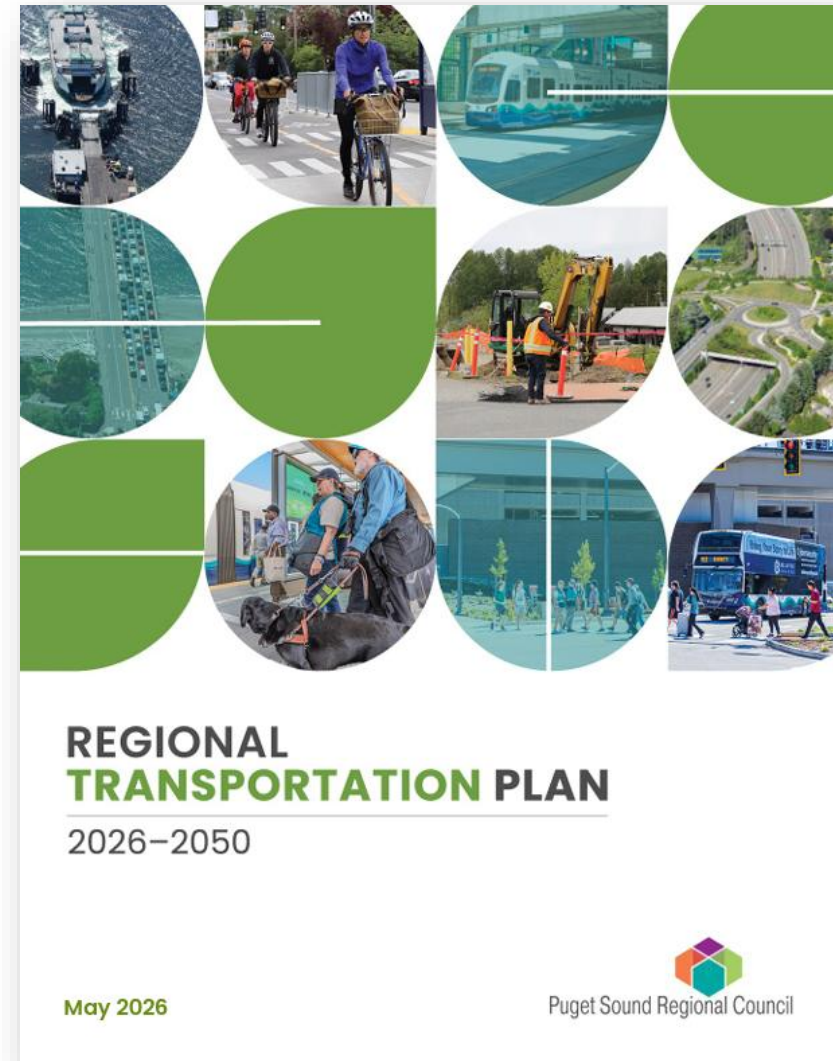
- Metropolitan Planning Organization, Regional Transportation Planning Organization

- Forum for regional issues

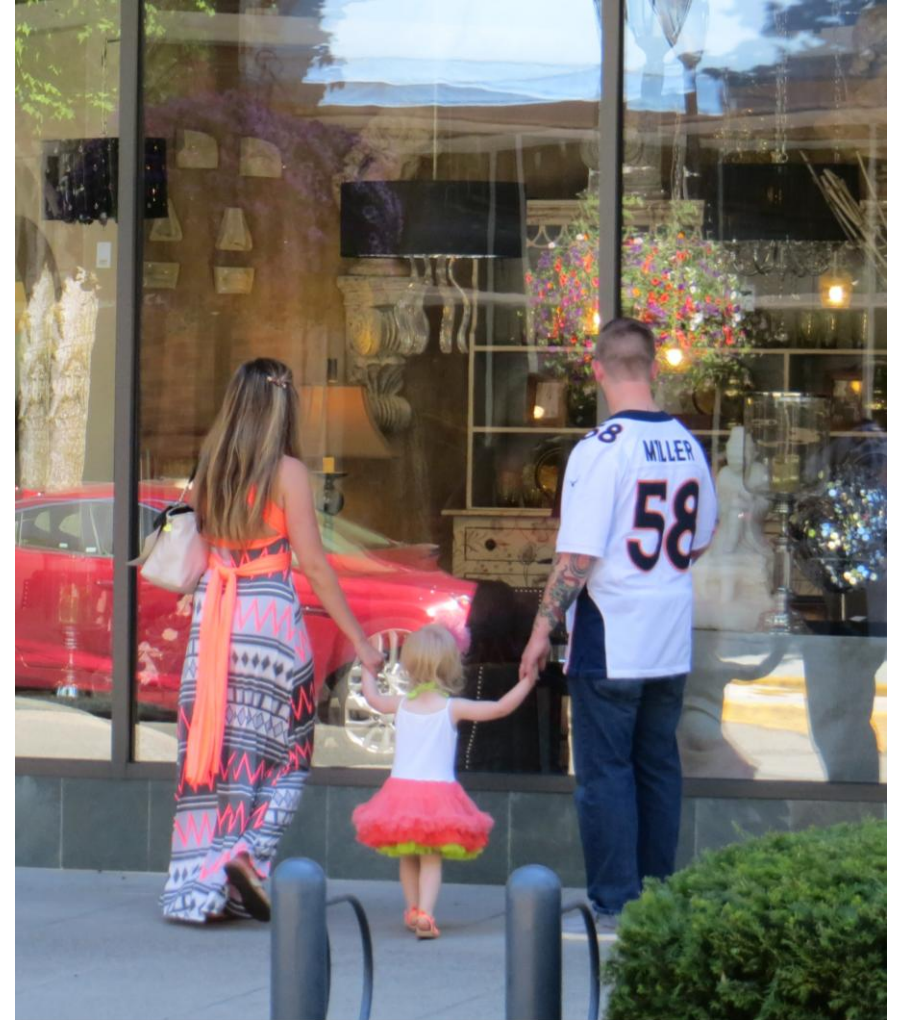
## Our members

# Overview of BPAC

- Coordinates with/advises PSRC staff on pedestrian and bicycle-related planning issues
- Membership is comprised of local jurisdictions, transit agencies, public health agencies and other interest groups



# BPAC Work Program

## Work program includes:

- Provide guidance on ped/bike data collection and other planning products in support of the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)
- Provide support for the development of active transportation elements of the RTP, including the Active Transportation Plan (ATP).
- Advise on other ped/bike planning efforts that involve data analysis, assessing needs & gaps, and monitoring pertinent policies/programs.



# BPAC Nonvoting Members

- Non-voting members are valuable contributors that bring unique and underrepresented perspectives on ped/bike issues to BPAC discussions
- Represent community, environmental, and educational organizations
- May participate in general discussions of the committee but may not vote
- BPAC may appoint up to five non-voting members



# BPAC Nonvoting Members (cont.)

- Expected to regularly attend bi-monthly meetings, participate and engage on a variety of topics
  - (Virtual) Meetings occur every other month on the second Tuesday morning of the month
- Non-voting member terms are four years
- Membership is organization-based – individuals representing the organization can be swapped out at any point in the term



# BPAC Nonvoting Members (cont.)

# Next Steps

1. Interested organizations will fill out a non-voting member application that asks about:
  - The perspective they would provide
  - The knowledge, expertise and skills the organization would bring to the committee.
2. PSRC staff to pre-screen applicants and provide a list to committee members for review
3. Hold a vote at an upcoming BPAC meeting to determine who fills the slots
4. After final decisions are made, appropriate responses will be sent to all candidates
