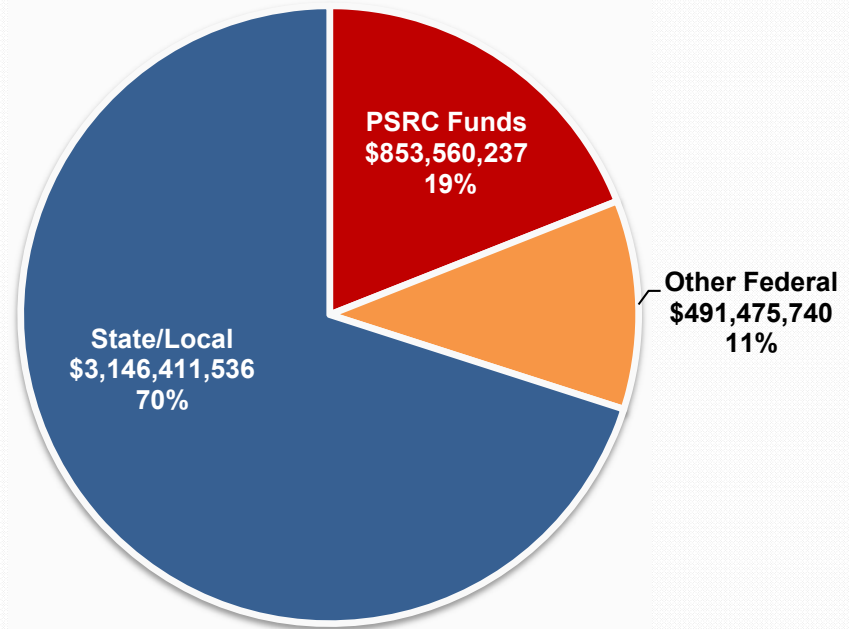

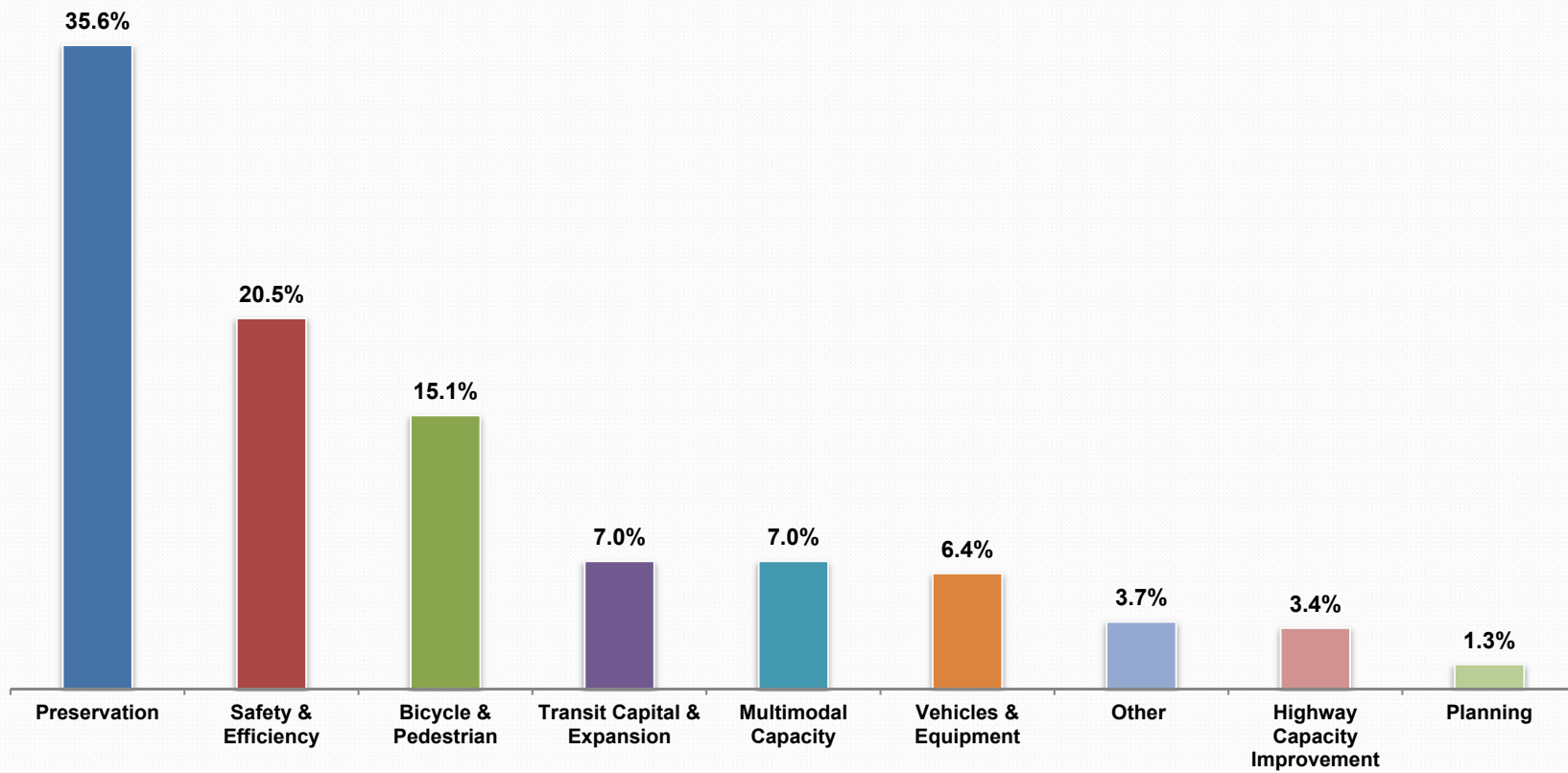
Total of \$4.5 billion

- detailed project information

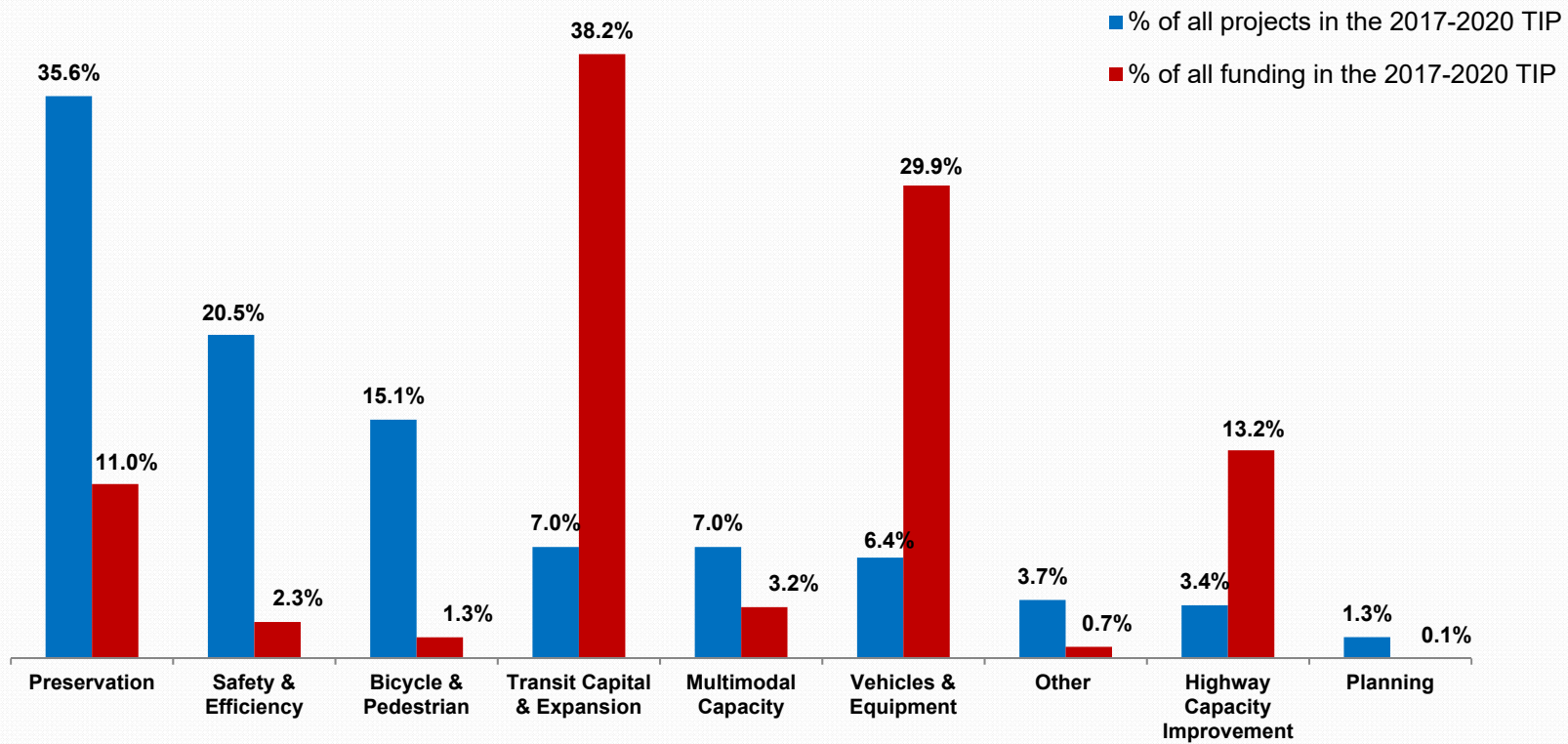
298 projects investing a total of \$16.7 billion over the next several years

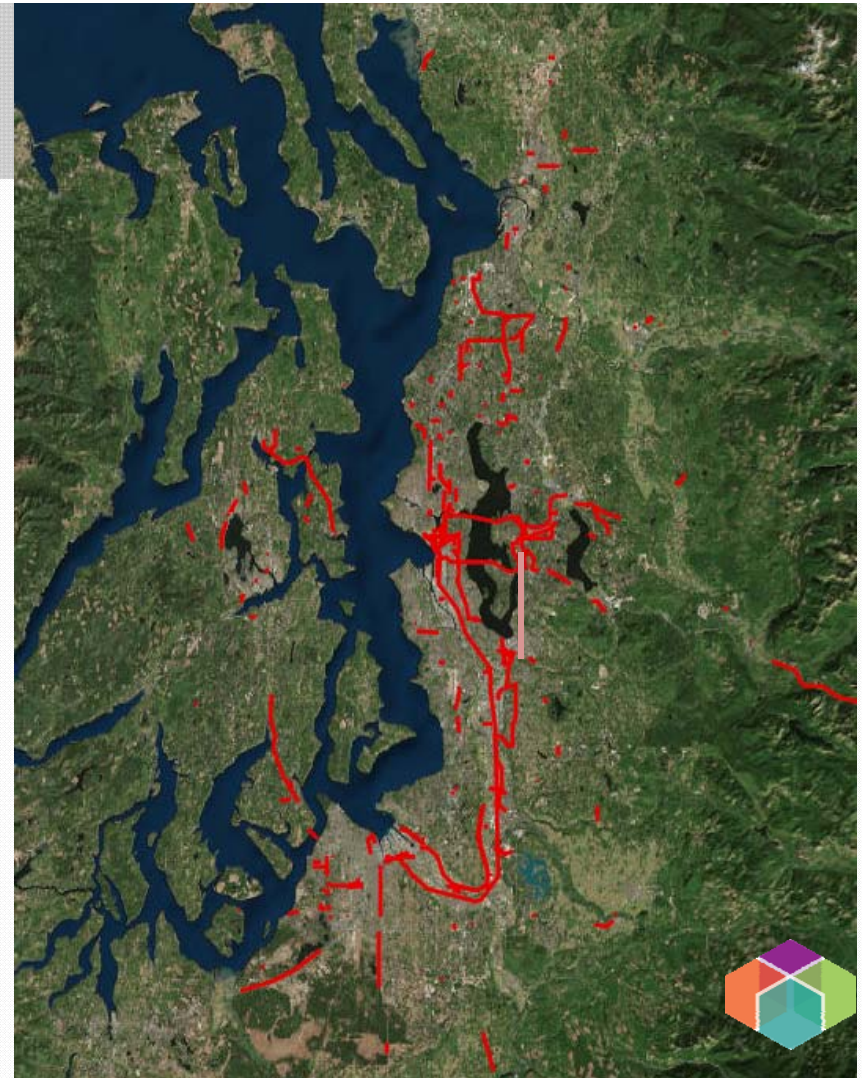

- SR 3/SR 304 Interchange Improvements



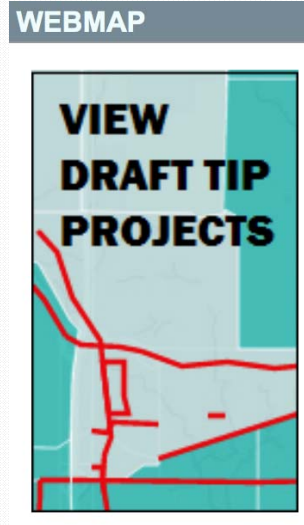
