Economic Development District Board adopts Regional Aviation Baseline Study Action Item

The study will provide a clearer picture of aviation activities and needs and set the stage for future planning efforts to meet growing demand at the region's airports.

The Regional Aviation Baseline Study is an implementation action item for *Amazing Place*, which calls for the development of a long-term strategy to ensure that the region's airports keep pace with the needs of an expanding population and economy.

The Federal Aviation Administration has requested that PSRC lead the aviation baseline study, which will build on airport master planning underway at many of the region's airports.

The study is expected to begin in June 2018 and be completed by the end of 2019.
