IN BRIEF

The Growth Management Policy Board will hold a VISION 2050 work session to discuss the draft Regional Growth Strategy preferred alternative and multicounty planning policies and actions.

DISCUSSION

The Growth Management Policy Board held an extended meeting on June 6, 2019, to discuss the draft Regional Growth Strategy preferred alternative and the draft multicounty planning policies and actions, and other items. The board made progress developing the preferred alternative and identified several questions for staff research and additional board discussion.

At the June 13 work session, staff will provide an overview of data requested by board members, and the board may continue discussion on policy issues and implementation. Several board members are unable to attend at this meeting time. The focus of the work session will be discussion and issue identification, not formal action. The board will be asked to take action on a preferred alternative for the draft VISION 2050 plan at its July 11, 2019, meeting.
