T2040 Maintenance & Preservation Working Group

Meeting Summary

June 1, 2017

1. Welcome and Introductions

Co-chair *Doug McCormick* welcomed everyone, followed by introductions around the room.

2. Public Comment

Two individuals signed up for public comment, but were not in the room when the public comment period was offered. No public comment was provided.

3. Discussion: Performance Metrics, Parking Lot Items, and Next Steps

Gary Simonson of PSRC then led a discussion regarding potential performance metrics to evaluate how the region is doing in terms of the desired regional outcome: "The existing transportation system is maintained and preserved in a state of good repair." For bridges, the group recommended using the percentage of bridges that are structurally deficient, the percentage of bridges that are functionally obsolete, and the average ratings for the three main bridge categories. For pavement, they proposed the percentage of lane mileage that is above a specific PCI score (to be determined) as well as the average pavement PCI score. The group agreed that ideally these metrics would include arterials and local roads, but recognized that data may be limited to arterials (at a minimum, only arterials on the NHS, as collected by WSDOT).

Gary Simonson and Doug McCormick then led a session to discuss "parking lot items" that should be addressed or considered during the next T2040 plan update. Finally, Gary provided a brief overview of next steps related to the maintenance and preservation expenditure estimates, the financial strategy, and the asset management proposal.
