The study will focus on street and sidewalk improvements; parking supply and demand; and the conceptual design of pedestrian, parking, transit, and streetscape improvements.
Kitsap County	SR 104 Realignment	Right of Way	87	\$ 1,400,000	\$1,400,000	This project will realign SR104 to move ferry traffic by adding two inbound travel lanes on NE 1st Street and remove two travel lanes on Main Street. The project will include sidewalks, ferry toll booth relocation, drainage improvements, lighting, signals, and street amenities.
Skykomish	US 2 Street Roundabout Design	Preliminary Engineering /Design	77	\$ 259,500	\$259,500	This project will design a three-legged roundabout with splitter islands at the intersection of 5th Street and US 2. The project will include sidewalk/sidepaths and crosswalks.
Stanwood	Viking Way Phase 2	Preliminary Engineering/Design	74	\$ 173,000	\$173,000	This project will provide design and right of way to extend Viking Way 200 feet to 92nd Avenue NW. This project includes a new road with curb, gutter, planter strips, streeting lighting, and sidewalks.

Carnation	Tolt Ave CBD Improvements, Eugene St to Rutherford St	Construction	71	\$ 450,000	\$450,000	This project constructs transportation improvements in Carnation's downtown including street re-grading and paving, widened shared-use sidewalks, curb bulbs, lighting, landscaping, and utility improvements.
Eatonville	SR 161/Washington Ave N. Corridor Streetscape Phase 2	Construction	70	\$ 2,145,200	\$2,145,200	This project will provide improvements along SR 161/ Washington Avenue N from approximately Center Street East to Lynch Creek Road E. Improvements include new sidewalks with ADA compliant curb ramps, lighting, stormwater drainage, landscaping, and a rapid rectangular flashing beacon system at the intersection of SR 161 and Carter Street E.
Roy	Yelm Prairie Line Trail	Planning	69	\$ 45,000	\$45,000	This project is a planning study to examine alignments of a shared use path from downtown Roy to the Nisqually River to connect Roy to the City of Yelm.

This project includes adding turn pockets, widening shoulders, and adding a new traffic signal or roundabout.
Pierce County	224th St E. Sidewalk Improvements	Construction	58	\$ 862,000	\$862,000	This project will provide sidewalks, curb, gutter, and lighting to gaps in the sidewalk network along the north side of 224th Street E.
