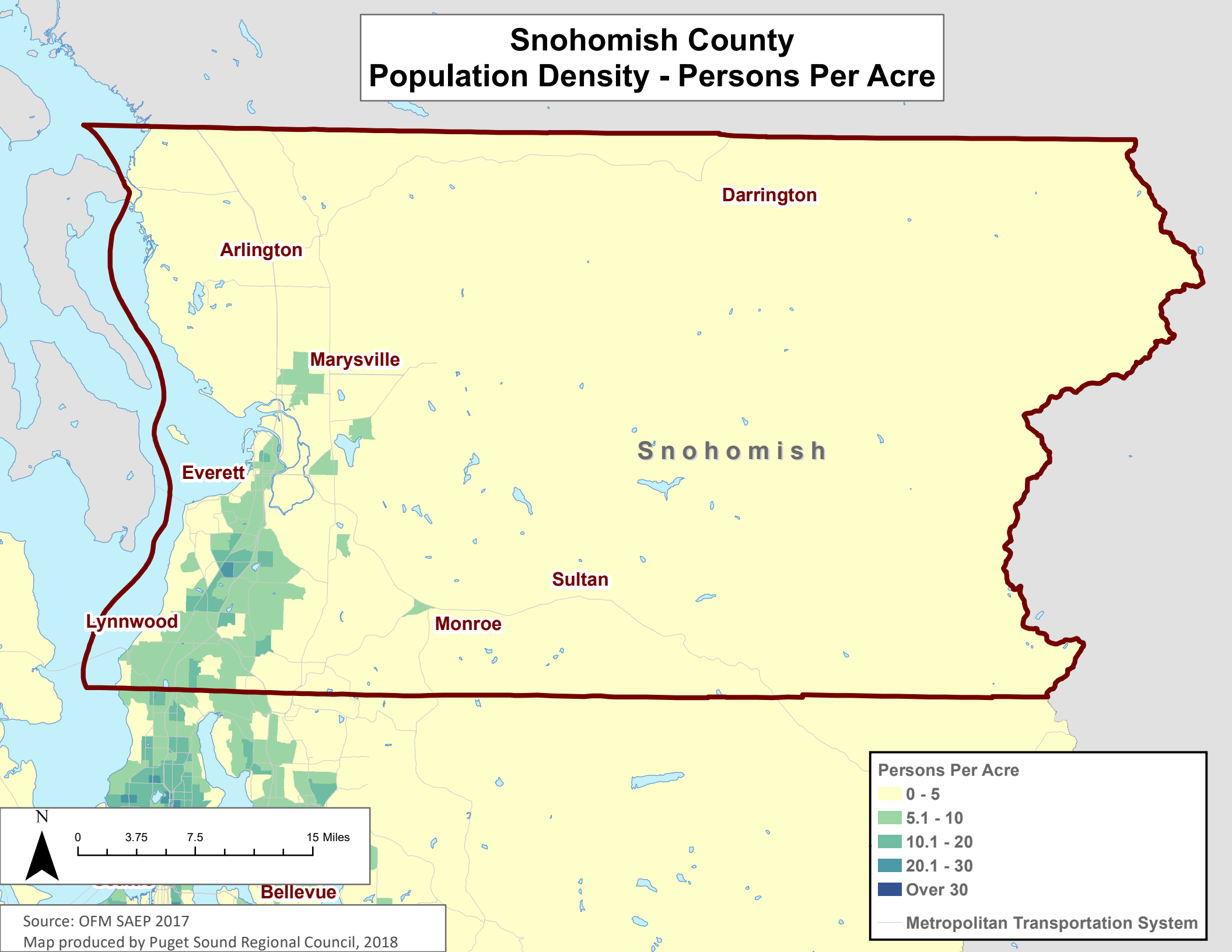


Snohomish County Population Density - Persons Per Acre
